

Requirements for Externships

Loma Linda University

-2 week externship in prosthodontics

-no cost for the program, but applicant is responsible for their own expenses

Requirements

1. resume
2. dental school transcript
3. a copy of part I NDBE score

UCLA

-can observe in any program

-Items to submit: application form, letter from dean indicating good standing and in 3rd or 4th year

-inform school of date of arrival and departure

UCSF

-two-week externship in the General Practice Residency Program in the Oral Maxillofacial Surgery Department

Requirements

- Completion of the Junior year of Dental School.
- Availability of 2 weeks.
- Completion of application for an elective at the University of California, San Francisco.
- Enrolled in a Dental school at the time of externship.
- We will require a dean's letter confirming academic good standing.
- We will require a letter from a Clinical Restorative Dentist confirming clinical competency.
- \$50 application fee. Checks should be payable to UC Regents.

University of Connecticut

Requirements:

- Photocopy of National Dental Board Scores - Part I
- Letter of recommendation from Chief of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery
- Letter of recommendation from Dean, with class rank
- Photocopy of dental school transcript
- Completed application
- Resume (please include Bachelors Degree information, including GPA)
- A one paragraph essay describing your motivation to participate in an externship

Indiana University

- Letter of intent indicating dates when you would like to participate in the externship
- Current CV or resume
- Letter of recommendation from a faculty of the OMFS department

- Letter from your Dental School indicating that you are enrolled in good standing. This letter must also provide permission from your institution certifying that your visit will not interfere with your regular curriculum
- Provide proof of liability insurance coverage (malpractice)
- Certification of HBV immunization, TB testing, HIPAA instruction and infection control instruction if the visiting student will be in any facility where patients are treated. Documentation that the visiting student has health insurance is also required or not the student will be in clinical facilities.

University of Kentucky

- An Externship in Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery is available for rising 3rd or 4th year Dental Students
- Medical Malpractice must be provided by the candidate either through their Dental School or independently
- A letter from the dean of their respective school should accompany their application
- Minimum time spent is 2 weeks

Baltimore College of Dental Surgery

- a two week externship in prosthodontics

Requirements

1. resume
2. letter of recommendation from a prothodontist at their school
3. dental school transcript
4. a copy of their part I NDBE score (Xerox)

University of Michigan

- externship for maxillofacial surgery
- up to three externs for any given time period
- externships are offered on a first come first served basis
- to qualify, you should have completed a basic clinical course in oral and maxillofacial surgery and be competent in dentoalveolar surgery and the administration of local anesthesia
- you should also be in good academic standing.

Requirements:

1. Preferably a least 1 week available, but we consider briefer visits
2. Be a dental student in good standing
3. A letter of support from dental school for insurance purposes

University of North Carolina School of Dentistry

- externship for maxillofacial surgery
- 2-4 week rotation
- 2 externs per month will be accepted

requirements:

- letter of intent

- application for visiting students must be filled out
- 2 letters of recommendation
- transcript from dental school
- letter of recommendation from the academic dean
- proof of current malpractice coverage
- basic life support training
- documentation within last 6 months of TB testing

University of Nebraska Medical Center College of Dentistry

- externship in OMFS
- 2-6 week externship
- living arrangements are the responsibility of the extern

requirements:

- application form should be received 2 months prior to externship
- personal statement
- transcript
- letter of references

University of Medicine & Dentistry of New Jersey New Jersey Dental School

- externships in GPR, OMFS, peds, prostho and perio

- externship application/waiver

Columbia University College of Dental Medicine

- externship in OMFS
- patient care responsibilities assigned according to students' abilities: students work closely with faculty and attending staff
- 2-4 week rotation but this is flexible (max time is 2 months)
- limit of 2 externs per month

requirements:

- externship application
- curriculum vitae
- personal statement
- good academic standing
- recommended that the visiting student has a personal health insurance policy
- 2 letters of recommendation (one from the Dean and another from the director of the General Practice Dentistry)

Ohio State University College of Dentistry

- externship in anesthesia, oral surg, perio
- anesthesiology: 1-2 week externship. Sound academic performance in areas important to anesthesiology important. student must have written permission and evidence of medical malpractice insurance from their home institution.
- oral surgery: one extern on rotation at any given time. Requirements: completion of 3rd year of dental school. class rank in the top 20%, availability during entire externship period, 2 letters of reference (one of which must be an oral and maxillofacial surgeon).

-perio: applicants must contact the program director directly. A current CV, written consent, verification of health insurance coverage, lists of immunizations and proof of malpractice coverage required.

University of Pennsylvania School of Dental Medicine

- externship in omfs
- one month externship for third or fourth year dental student

University of Pittsburgh School of Dental Medicine

- AEGD externship
- application form required (mailed before May 15)
- proof of personal health insurance
- extern must seek own housing

Baylor College of Dentistry Component of Texas A & M Health Sci Ctr

- externship in OMFS
- externship for a minimum of 4 weeks
- maximum of 3 externs per month
- letters of recommendation from the dean and at least one OMS faculty
- must provide malpractice and medical care insurance coverage

Univ. of Texas Hlth Science Cnt-Houston Dental Branch

- externship in OMFS

requirements:

- dental school transcript with documentation of class rank
- NBDE part 1 if available
- Letter of reference from chair of OMFS
- verification of malpractice coverage
- personal letter of request for application which includes preferred externship dates
- online application submitted at least 6 months in advance

University of Texas Hlth Science Cnt-San Antonio Dental School

- externships in AEGD, endo, hospital dentistry, oral and maxillofacial radiology, OMFS, peds, perio

Virginia Commonwealth University School of Dentistry

- externship in OMFS

requirements:

- 2 letters of recommendation
- official transcript
- accomodation is available for a nominal fee

University of Washington-Health Sciences School of Dentistry

- externship in OMFS

requirements:

- current CV

- 2 letters of recommendation
- letter from school verifying you are in good academic standing and this is approved as part of your curriculum
- application form
- documentation of health insurance
- proof of immunizations
- data security and patient confidentiality understanding form
- criminal background check

McGill University

- externship at the Summer Dental Clinic for the Disabled

Requirements:

Entering the last 2 years of their program may apply for a position as an observer.

To apply, applicants must submit the following:

- Completed Application Form (below)
- Letter of Good Standing from the Dean of their Faculty or Program
- Attestation of Immunization Status
- Curriculum Vitae

Proof of immunization will only be requested once you have been officially accepted into the program. The University's immunization requirements can be found in Section 3.1.11 of the McGill University Health Science Calendar.

Proof of professional liability. (malpractice insurance) is not required.

To be competitive, applicants should have experience in the following areas of dentistry: Periodontics, Operative Dentistry, Oral Surgery and Radiology.
